



Frost Delay Policy:

Frost occurs when temperatures drop below freezing, causing moisture on the ground to freeze, resulting in hazardous conditions for golfers and potential damage to the turf.

Communication:

- When the Superintendent notifies the Pro Shop that frost will be an issue, we will enact the following steps to ensure our golfers are informed
- Golfers will be notified of any frost delays via email, via the Tee On notifications option
- Updates regarding the status of the frost delay will be sent via Tee On email, and communicated on site through the Pro Shop and the Starters

Duration of Delay:

- The duration of the frost delay will depend on several factors, including the severity of the frost, weather forecast, and time needed for the frost to thaw.
- Golfers should expect delays ranging from 30 minutes to several hours, depending on conditions.

Course Opening:

- The golf course will reopen once temperatures rise above freezing, and golf course conditions are deemed safe for play.
- Golfers will be informed when the course is open for play, and tee times will be adjusted accordingly. The Starter will work to make up time throughout the day.
- Golfers may choose to cancel tee times without penalty for any tee times affected by the frost delay. Green Fees should not be paid until there is a confirmed opening time for the golf course.

Enforcement:

- Golf course staff, including the starter and pro shop attendants, are responsible for enforcing the frost delay policy.
- Golfers are not allowed on the Putting Green or the golf course until the Frost Delay has ended, any abuse of this policy is unacceptable.
