



Handicap Flag Policy

Purpose:

This policy is intended to provide equitable access to the golf course for golfers with mobility challenges while protecting the health and quality of the golf course.

Eligibility:

Golfers requesting a handicap flag must:

- Have a permanent or temporary mobility impairment
- Make a request through the Pro Shop prior to their tee time

General Conduct:

- Handicap flags are a privilege extended to golfers with verified mobility needs and are subject to revocation if misused

Cart Path Usage:

- Golfers must use cart paths whenever possible
- Carts must return to the cart path, immediately after approaching the green or teeing ground area, upon exiting the area

Proximity to Greens, Tees, and Bunkers:

- Carts must remain a minimum of 30 feet (10 metres) from all putting greens, tee boxes, and bunker edges unless on a designated cart path
- At no time may a cart be driven between a green and a greenside bunker

Violations of this policy may result in loss of cart access, removal of handicap flag privileges, or further disciplinary action.
