



### **Pippy Park Music Policy:**

One of our main priorities here at Pippy Park is to ensure that each and every guest truly has an enjoyable time at the golf course. As the popularity of music on the golf course has risen, we want to ensure that all of our guests are able to enjoy their time on the golf course without disrupting the pleasure of other guests during their rounds. For this reason, we have developed a standard music policy that we hope will ensure that all of our guests are beyond satisfied with their on course experience.

### **Music amongst your own foursome:**

- Please maintain the volume at a level that is not easily heard from beyond 20 yards.
- Please be prepared to turn the volume down when in very close contact with other groups, especially near greens
- Please keep the speaker in the cart

### **Music when paired with other guests:**

- Please ask other players if they are ok with you playing music, also please consider what type of music they may like to hear and consider playing songs within their preference
- Please make sure the music is at a manageable volume
- Understand your environment – not every course and golfer feel the same about music during a round
- Please keep the speaker in the cart

### **Staff/Management:**

- If the starter is aware that a group will be playing music during their round, please be prepared to acknowledge that and address it in an appropriate manner before the group starts their round, in order to set expectations
- The Marshall should be prepared to observe and manage any situations that may arise due to music being played on the golf course
